Showroom Cinema, Sheffield

Renovated from the 1930s Kennings' car garage and showroom, the Showroom is one of the biggest independent cinemas in the UK. The venue is perfect for talks, as well as films. Due to the popularity of the day we are again using the largest of the cinemas at the Showroom.

The venue has space for displays by clubs and societies, as well as space for the bookshop (provided by O N Books). As in previous years, tea and coffee will be provided, and participants will be able to browse round the displays and bookshop during refreshment breaks.

The Showroom is only a few minutes' walk from Sheffield train station. There is car parking nearby, but those driving from further afield might like to use the park & ride car parks on the Supertram system and take the tram into the city centre.
